Bids on the following projects will be received by the Montana Department of Transportation, Construction Contracting Bureau, until 9:00 a.m. on MAY 16, 2024. All bids will then be reviewed for correctness and then publicly read in the Department's assigned room.

Bid proposals, plans, cross-sections, dirt runs & erosion control plans, if available, and full instructions to bidders may be obtained from the Construction Contracting Bureau's website: <http://www.mdt.mt.gov/business/contracting> under the "Bid Package" link. Additional bid letting information is also available on this website.

Persons or firms desiring to qualify or bid on highway construction on the basis of a joint venture must declare their intention by executing a "Declaration of Joint Venture and Power of Attorney." Joint Venture affidavits must be included with the Bid Proposal.

Any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement is subject to all appropriate state and federal civil rights laws. The prime and subcontractors are required to pay the wage rates set out in the bid proposal.

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The following projects are funded in whole or in part by funds received from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), and their construction is wholly contingent on the state's continued receipt of those federal funds. If the federal funds are reduced or not received, the Department may choose to terminate any or all of the contracts for convenience under the provisions of Subsection 108.10. Any bidder on these projects, by submitting its bid or bids, understands and accepts the possibility of the contracts being terminated in the event federal funds are reduced or not available and by submitting any bid, each bidder waives any claims for costs or damages other than as specifically allowed by Subsection 108.10.2. In particular, bidders understand and accept that no payment will be allowed for any claimed anticipated profit for work not performed.

Project Corvallis - North will perform the following work: •0.15' asphalt mill and overlay from reference post (RP) 5.3 to 8.5. •0.15' asphalt mill and overlay 50' north and south of the railroad crossing at RP 5.1. •Remove the MRL at-grade railroad crossing structure, railroad crossing signals and signal foundations located at RP 5.1 and backfill with crushed aggregate course, plant mix, and embankment in place. •Chip seal and fog seal the existing pavement from RP 4.8 to 12.2 (omit the fog seal through the Town of Corvallis). •Crack seal and mastic crack fill from RP 4.8 to 5.1, 5.1 to 5.3, and 8.5 to 12.2, as needed. Other work will include pavement markings, signing and delineation, centerline rumble strips, median curb removal and replacement, guardrail, guardrail end section widening, revegetation, fog sealing of SUP, and ADA sidewalk upgrades to the pedestrian crossing just north of the intersection of 1st Street and Eastside Highway. The project begins at RP 4.8 and extends about 7.4 miles north along S-269 (Eastside Highway), ending at RP 12.2.

Site 1 will install luminaires for destination lighting, double oversized stop ahead signs, double oversized stop signs with reflective strip on posts, transverse rumble strips, and double-sided arrow. Site 2 will install vehicle-activated flashers on existing curve warning signs. Site 3 will add shoulder rumble strips. Sites 4-18 will install a varying combination of: double oversized stop signs, double oversized advanced warning-intersection signs, double oversized advanced warning-stop ahead signs, pavement word and/or symbol markings, lighting, post mounted reflective delineators, and flashing beacons on stop signs.
