**The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT)** plans to improve approximately five miles of US 87, West of Divide, near Lewistown. The improvements include:

- Realignment, where needed
- Drainage improvements
- Signage
- Centerline rumble strips will be added to improve safety for the traveling public
