

Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) has received \$71,297 in On-The-Job Training Supportive Services (OJT/SS) funding from the Federal Highway Administration and is seeking solicitation for these funds. These funds are meant to increase the effectiveness of approved on-the-job training programs, particularly their effectiveness in providing meaningful training opportunities for minorities, women, and the disadvantaged on Federal-aid highway projects. MDT's Statement of Work (SOW) is attached and contains more information about the program requirements. The performance period will run for one year from the date the contracts are signed.

If you are interested in applying for these funds, please submit a SOW to MDT that is no longer than ten (10) pages. Your SOW must contain the following items:

- Your Program Qualifications
- Performance Goals
- Budget

SOWs must be submitted no later than 5:00 pm on January 6, 2017 to:
