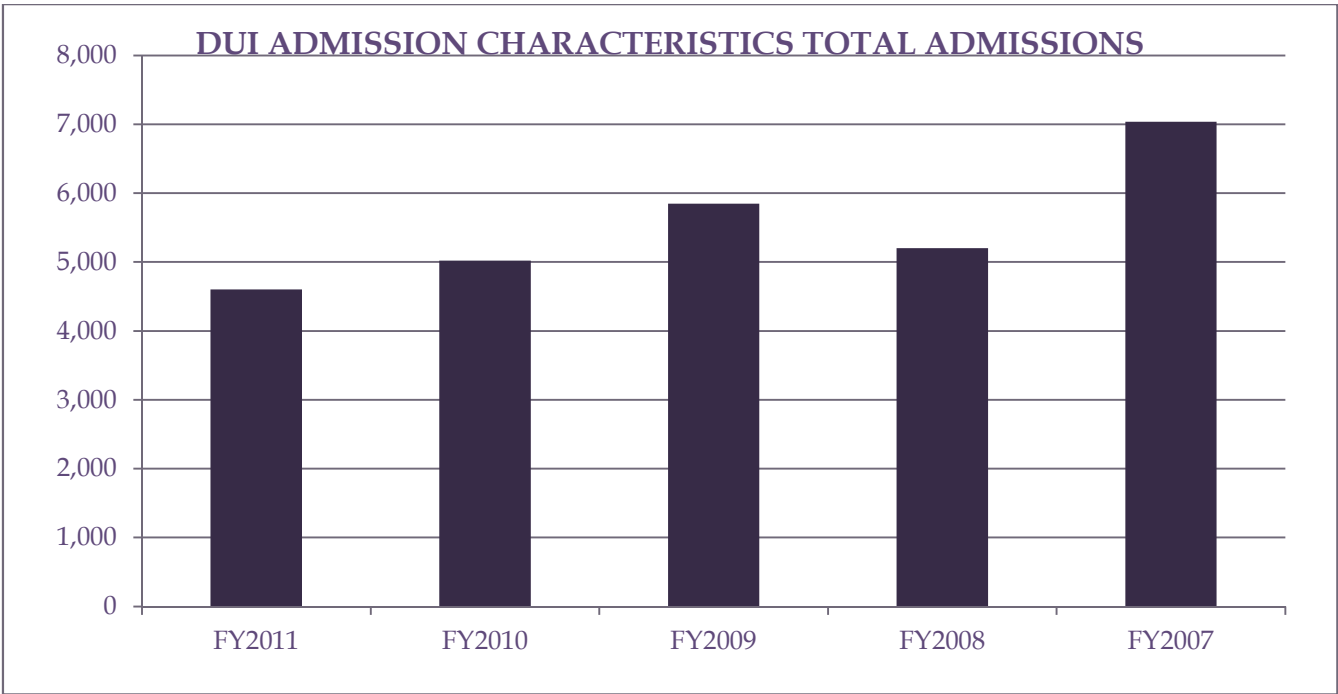

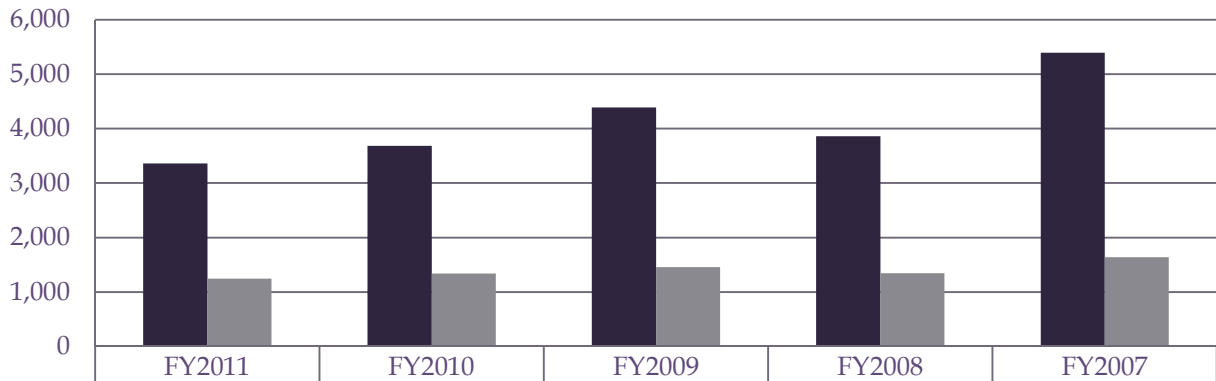
*****Note:**

At the end of FY2010, there was a change in the way our providers determined the discharge reason. Up to that time, any client who completed the education component of the A.C.T. program was discharged as *Complete*, regardless of Assessment/Evaluation results.

Beginning in FY2011, the providers will only use *Discharge Complete* for those clients who are assessed as *Misuse/No Problem*. Clients who complete the education course but are assessed as *substance abusers* or *chemically dependent* must be marked as *Referred to Treatment*, as required by state law (MCA 61-8-732). Treatment is **required** for first-time DUI offenders if a licensed addiction counselor (LAC) finds the individual to be chemically dependent (MCA 61-8-732 (8)). In addition, if the client has more than 1 DUI, Mandatory Monitoring will be required.

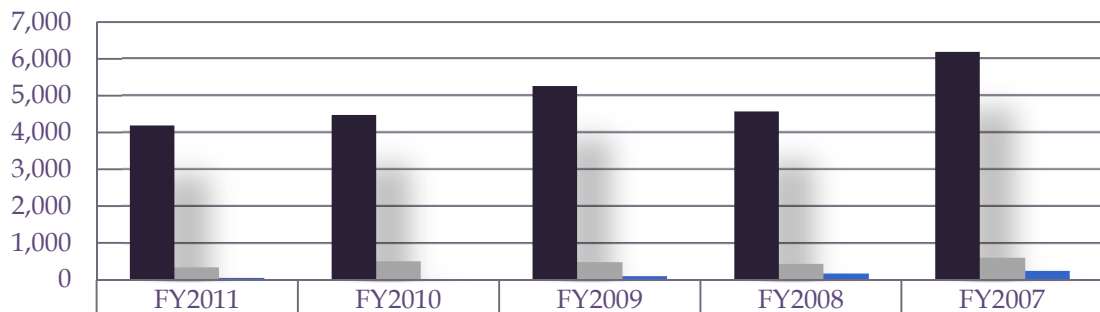


DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY GENDER



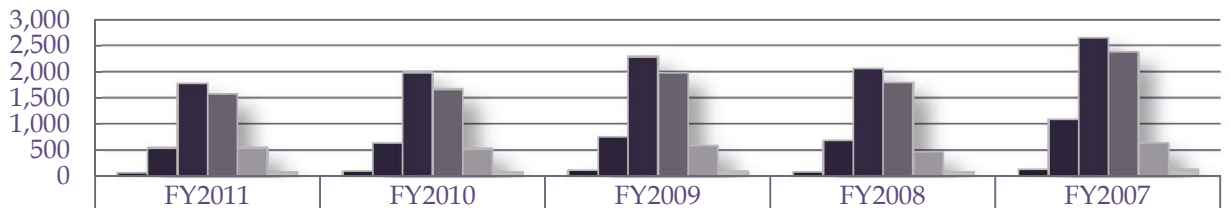

DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY RACE



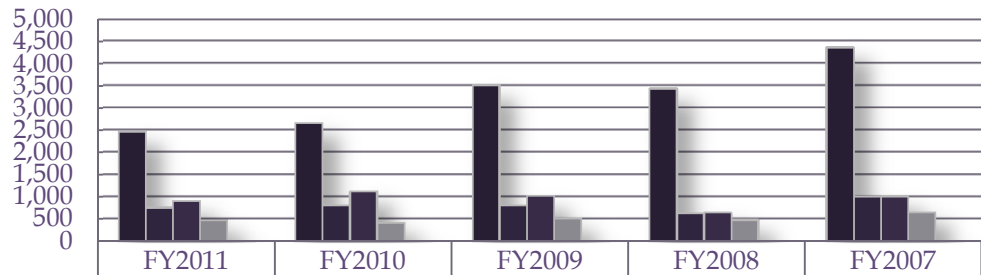

DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY AGE AT ADMISSION



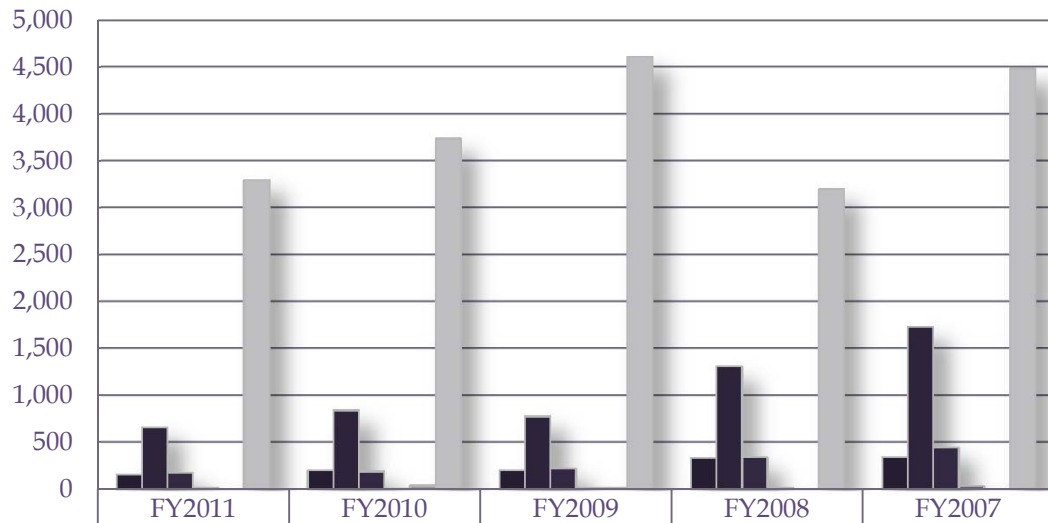

DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY EMPLOYMENT STATUS



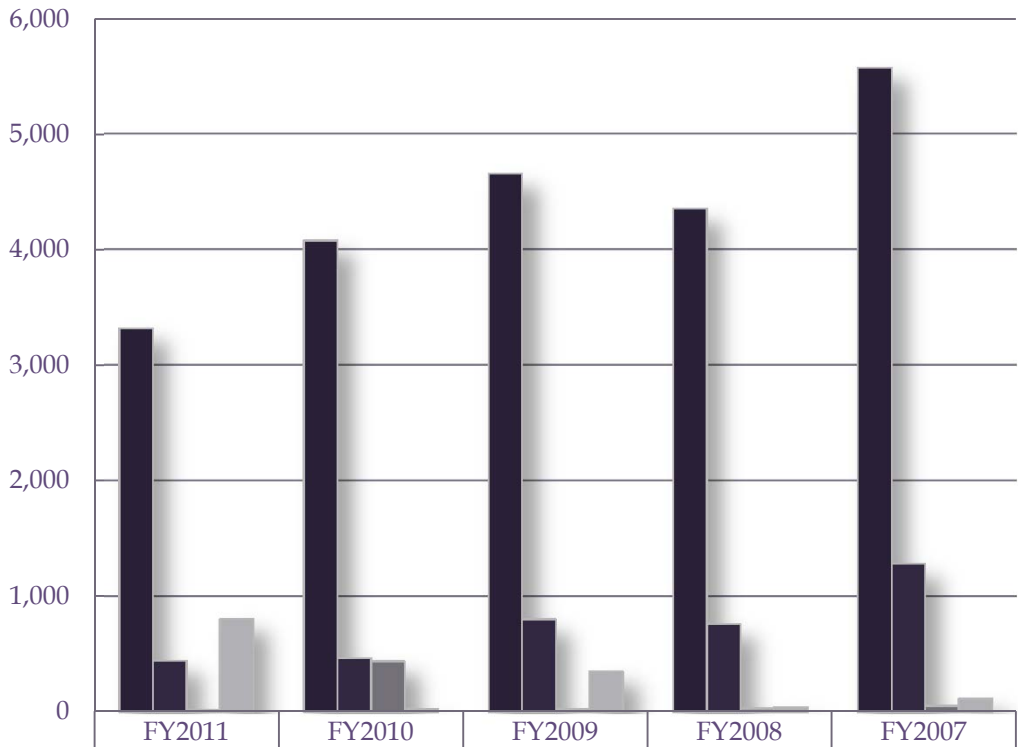

DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY BAC



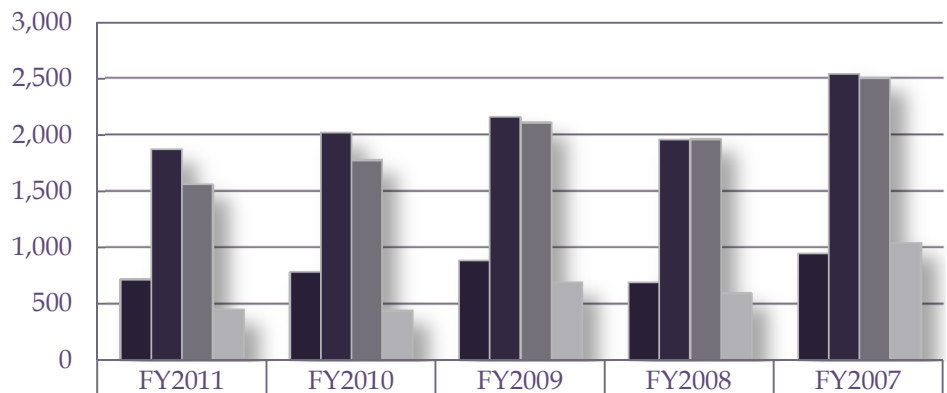

DUIADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY DISCHARGE REASON



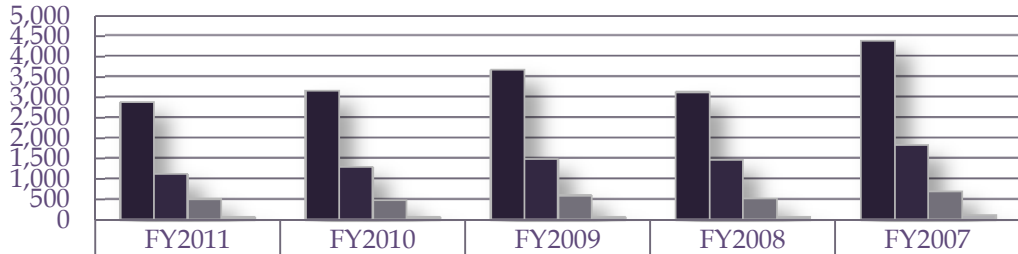

DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY ASSESSMENT/EVALUATION



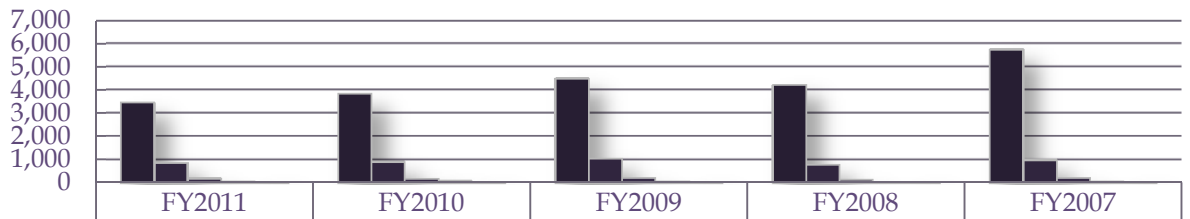

DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY TREATMENT RECOMMENDATION



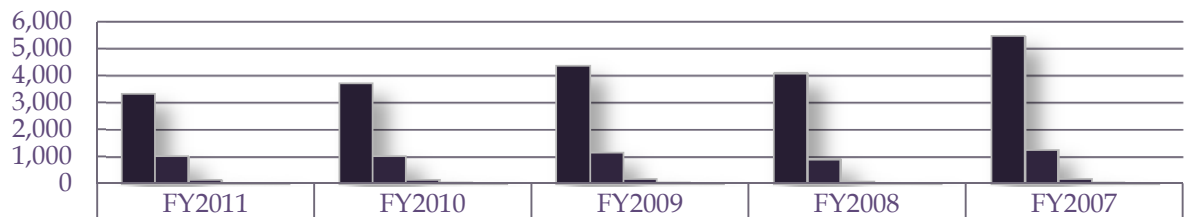

DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY # OF PRIOR DUI/BAC CONVICTIONS



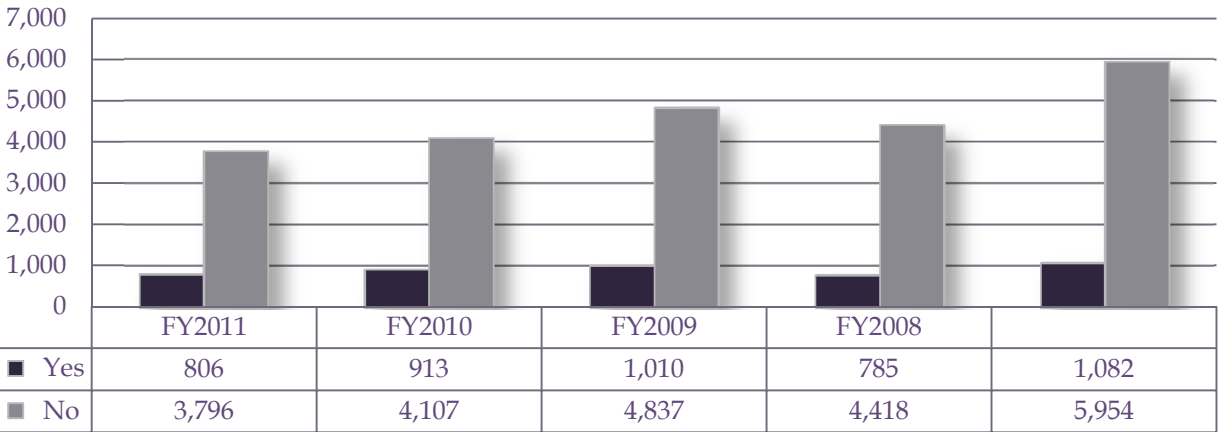

DUI ADMISSION CHARACTERISTICS BY # OF PRIOR ACT PROGRAMS

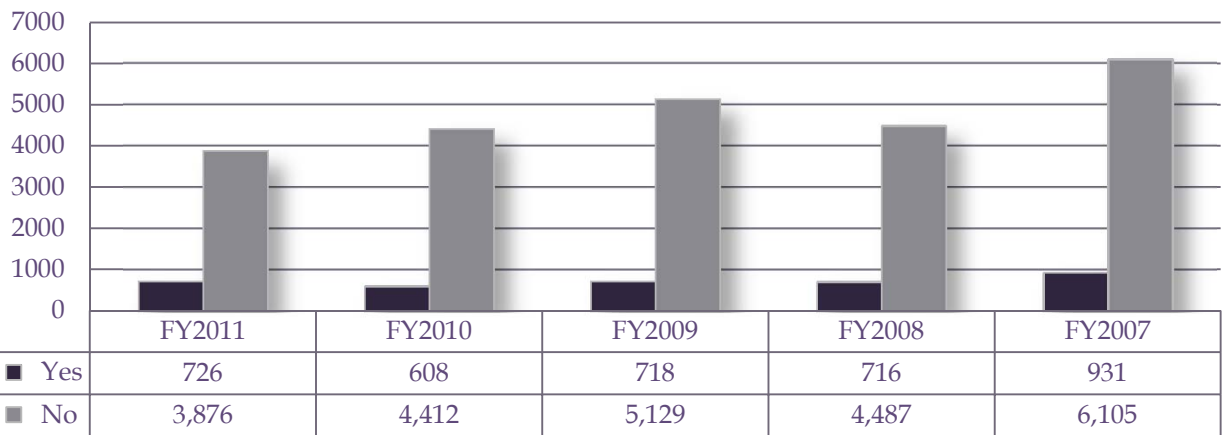
