- Each year the State Highway Traffic Safety Section submits a HSP (Section 402) to NHTSA
- We post the HSP on our website as soon as NHTSA approves the plan

NHTSA Safety Programs MAP-21

- Section 402 – Highway Safety Plan funding & Teen Traffic Safety Plan
- Section 405(B) – Occupant Protection
- Section 405 (C) – Traffic Records, Data and IT Projects
- Section 405 (D) – Impaired Driving, High Visibility Enforcement
- Section 405 (F) – Motorcycles

Safety Grant Application Process

- **Annual process** – Applications due March 1st
- **Tie to CHSP** - Proposal needs to be a strategy in CHSP (updated 2015)
- **Applications ranked** – grant decisions will be based on ranking criteria - data analysis, goals & objectives, past performance, and other considerations
- **Award** - Governor's Representative (GR) for Highway Traffic Safety – Director Tooley makes final decision – notification of funding sent to applicants
- **NHTSA** – Grant projects are compiled into annual Highway Safety Plan submitted to NHTSA by July 1st annually

FFY 2017 Annual Grant Cycle

(10/1/16 – 09/30/17)

- **March 1st, 2016** – Applications due to SHTSS through webgrants
- **March – April, 2016** – SHTSS review and GR approve funding recommendation
- **May 1 – June 30, 2016** – HSP prepared & approved by GR
- **July 1, 2016** – Highway Safety Plan due to NHTSA
- **August 30, 2016** - NHTSA notifies state of HSP approval status
- **September 1, 2016** – Notification letters sent to applicants
- **October 1, 2016** – signed contracts due from grantees
