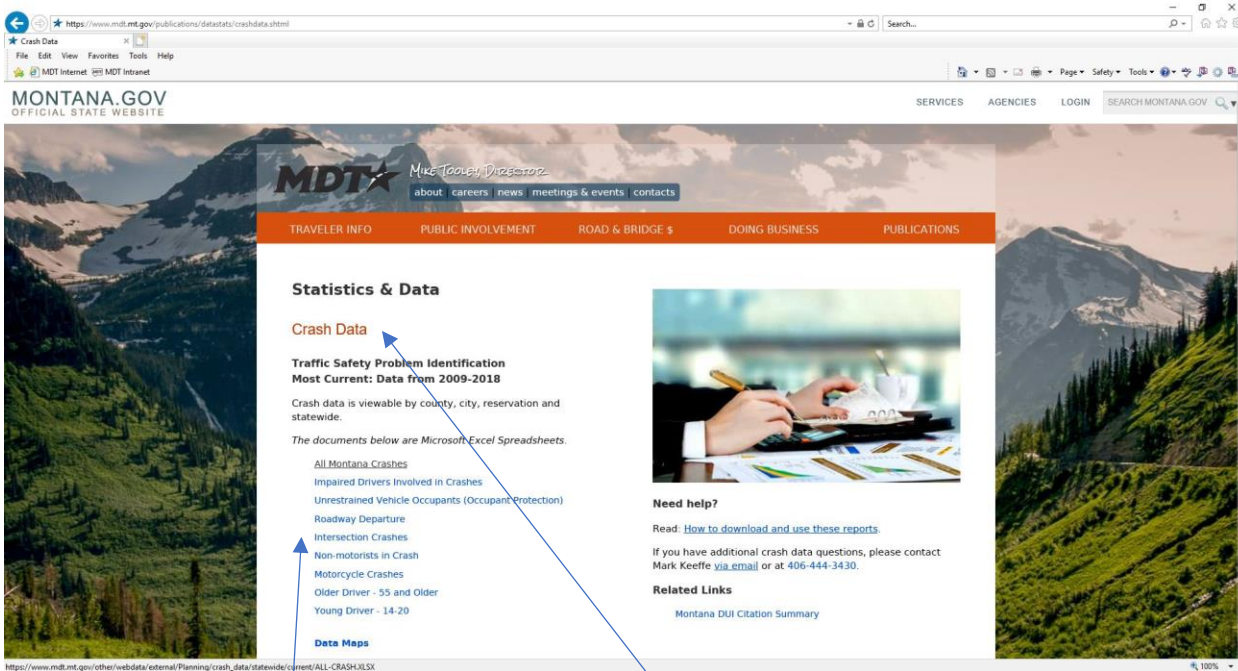


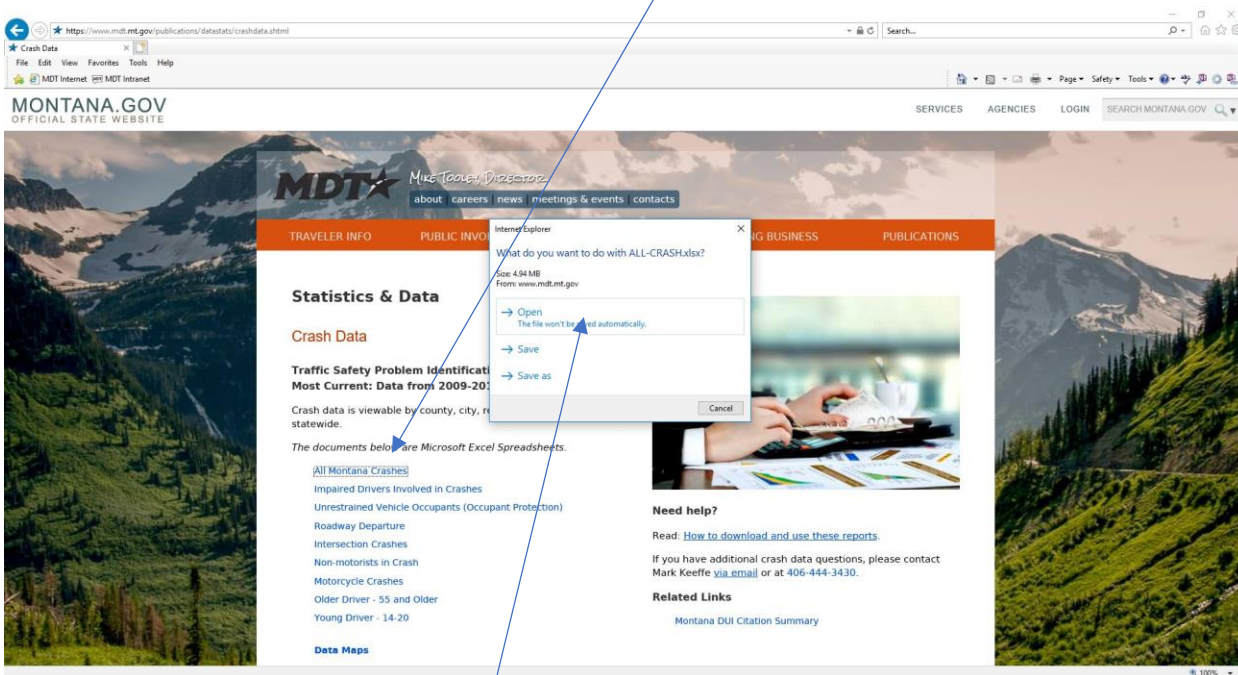
Guide for downloading files from this webpage (September 2019)

So, you should have found these instructions from the page shown below



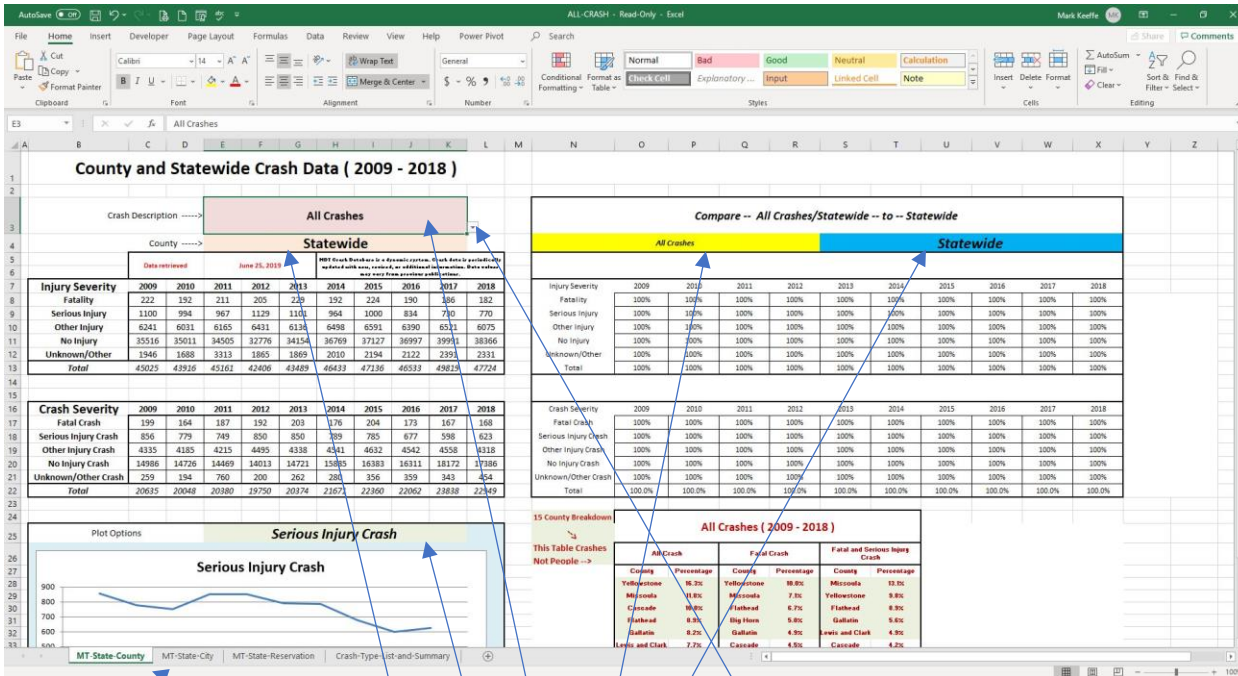
The blue text list below **Crash Data** identify downloadable Excel crash data files.

Clicking on one of the blue file names will/should provide an image like below.



Selecting **Open** will/should display the image on the following page.

Your computer (or Excel program) may display an option to “Enable Editing” or some other file access message, you should respond “affirmative” to these message(s) to use these files. There are **no macros** associated with these files.



The image above shows the

- “MT-State-County” worksheet
- “All Crashes” - Crash Description cell
- “Statewide” – County cell
- “All Crashes” – yellow comparison cell
- “Statewide” – blue comparison cell
- “Serious Injury Crash” – Plot Option
- “Little Right-side-of-cell arrow” that provides access to the cell’s list
