<u>Project scope:</u> This project constructed ADA-compliant concrete sidewalk and asphalt shared-use path. The purpose of the project was to provide a city-wide connection to the existing shared-use path network and provide connection between Granite Peak Park and Itch-Kep-Pe Park. Three project segments were constructed: a west segment on East Pike Avenue (Highway 306) from Quarry Street to the existing sidewalk; a south segment on Highway 78 from Itch-Kep-Pe Park to 1st Avenue South; a north segment from the intersection of Pike Avenue and Pratten Street to Granite Peak Park including portions along Pratten Street, 1st Avenue North, and Highway 78 (N. 9th Street).
