Agenda:

1. Introduction

- The PIT Crew went over the purpose and objectives of the meeting and members introduced themselves. Brian Klapstein, MDT GIS Specialist, attended as a proxy for Brian Andersen.

2. Steering Committee's feedback

- MDT, MSWP, FWP shared the feedback and guidance from the respective entities. These comment documents were provided electronically to the D&I members. Key direction included:
 - Everyone is very impressed with the composition of the workgroup and the great start on direction and workplan
 - Take a stepwise approach and focus on Recommendation 4a and Action 7
 - Start with a needs assessment, not a list of priority projects, not feasibility
 - Product should include an interactive mapping tool with informative layers to be turned on and off by users. Tool should be created to support and inform decisions
 - The wording is important to ensure clarity and set appropriate expectations – stay away from “priority” and “hot spot”
 - It was suggested to consider and document what this effort is, what it is not, and what are the sensitivities – keep this list updated as concerns emerge

- Take a look at some recent efforts by other states (CO, ID, WY) to get ideas that make sense for MT effort – CLLC is working on a summary document of these efforts and can provide when ready
- Separate the identification of areas of need and areas with specific data gaps/research needs. This effort can inform a variety of projects from accommodations to research
- Consider implementation criteria and process guidance under a second phase, in line with Recommendation 4b and Action 9
