



STEERING COMMITTEE

The Steering Committee has been formed and is comprised of two representatives each from MDT, FWP, and MSWP. The Steering Committee will work on developing a charter that outlines their specific roles and responsibilities.

The role of the Steering Committee is to consider recommendations resulting from the Summit, make decisions regarding actions moving forward, and direct all work under the Summit themes. This may include the formation of work groups and task prioritization to ensure resource capacity and balance within existing programs. The Steering Committee will coordinate with other efforts working on wildlife and transportation issues, such as U.S. Department of Interior Secretarial Order 3362, to avoid duplication of efforts and competition of resources.
