  - 1. MHP Crash database has languished due to covid19, but should be getting more attention now.
- Tricia Burke
  - 1. New crash analysis system is moving ahead.
  - 2. Current crash database is on an old platform and must be moved to a newer system. Done by end of 2020
  - 3. TRCC may have options to help with the new crash analysis/database system in the works
- Janet Kenny
  - 1. MDT Traveler Website still active, but currently only showing status updates.
  - 2. Still looking to have SHTSS HSP submitted by July 1, 2020. NHTSA has extended the deadline to August 1, 2020
  - 3. May mobilization has been moved from May to November
  - 4. Texting and driving messaging later in 2020
  - 5. Summer messaging getting ramped up
  - 6. 4<sup>th</sup> of July mobilization on impaired driving
