- 3. Financial Statement Bill Tuck and Janet Kenny
 - TRCC receives roughly \$ 350,000 annually
 - There is currently a back log of funds
 - Lapsing funds trying to spend older money before it lapses. Working with NHTSA to establish plan for dealing with large funding balance. NHTSA has established that funding for a new TRCC Strategic Plan is not an option. NHTSA has proposed TRCC participate in a full STRAP assessment, hosting a strategic planning workshop to gather ideas from neighbor states (WA, OR, AK, ID), and enlisting the help of a NHTSA GO Team. MT's preference is planning workshop.
 - Alyssa Johnson reported on the Driller project. Roll out of Driller and user training began in early September. Driller project funding may not be submitting any more invoices.

- a. DPHHS Terry Mullins
 - EMS Reports Training
 - 1. Montana now has an EMS registry compliant with national requirements
 - 2. DPHHS working to link EMS and Trauma databases
 - 3. Have found that EMS data quality and completeness are somewhat lacking in order to move forward
 - 4. Proposing to work directly (via contractor) with EMS agencies to train EMS personnel in using the new reporting system more effectively. Better data input and user use of EMS database will enable DPHHS and EMS agencies to develop and implement performance improvement tools. Currently, DPHHS does not have the staff to implement necessary performance improvements.
 - 5. DPHHS is proposing a 2 year effort to provide the education and training of EMS agencies.
 - a. <u>ACTION:</u> TRCC voted to move forward with funding the proposal, contingent on NHTSA review and approval.
- b. Fatal Analysis Reporting System (FARS) support Janet Kenny
 - 1. Under a cooperative agreement with FARS/NHTSA, the TRCC provide financial support for Montana's FARS activities.
 - 2. MDT is asking that the TRCC provide \$ 55,000 per year for the next five years.
 - a. <u>ACTION</u>: TRCC voted to move forward with funding this proposal, contingent on NHTSA review and approval.
