

LAND OWNERSHIP: MONTANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (MDT)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Vida wetland mitigation site was constructed in 1995 to mitigate wetland impacts associated with Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) Vida North and South project. Constructed in Watershed #12 (Lower Missouri), the site is located south of Vida and west of Highway 13. The intent of this mitigation project was to create 3.9 acres of additional wetlands within an intermittent drainage by placing a cross-drainage dike upstream of an existing reservoir. Minor excavation was performed upstream of the dike to enhance wetland development. Unfortunately, the site did not develop as intended; therefore, MDT purchased In Lieu Fee mitigation credits from the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks to offset these mitigation debits in 2007.
