Answer: A3, B3, C3, D3, E3

b. You may need to yield to a vehicle coming from which box?

Answer: B3

c. Beginning from where the car is presently located, list all the boxes you would need to travel over to get through the intersection.

Answer: C5, D5, C4, D4, C3, D3

You are preparing to make a left turn. You are looking out the driver's side window. In which boxes do you see blockages to your line of vision that conceal your path of travel?

Answer: C5, D5, C4, D4, A3, B3, C3, D3

Which one box presents the most dangerous line-of-sight blockage to your intended path of travel?

Answer: D1

Which one box is most necessary to search to detect something concealed by a line-ofsight blockage?

Answer: D3

Situation 7

a. Which box is most important to search at this moment?

Answer: E2

b. Which box is most important to search two seconds later?

Answer: C2

In which box is a crash most likely to occur due to driving too fast?

Answer: B2

Situation 9

In which box should your speed be the slowest?

Answer: C2

Situation 10

Which box(es) should you search to detect a problem affecting the right side of the lane?

Answer: C3 or D3

Situation 11

In which box should your lane position be to the left side of the lane?

Answer: D3

Situation 12

a. In which box should your lane position be to the left side of the lane?

Answer: C2

b. In which boxes are there vehicles creating a line-of-sight blockage to your path of travel?

Answer: A2, D2

Situation 13

To compensate for line-of-sight blockages, which boxes should be searched? List them in the order of your approach.

Answer: E2, D2, B2, C2

Situation 14

In which box should speed be the slowest?

Answer: B2

Situation 15

If a car going in our direction (Car A) and a car approaching from the opposite direction (Car B) were to drift off the road surface, which car would have the greatest potential for rolling over while attempting to get back onto the road surface?

Answer: Car A

Situation 16

If your vehicle unintentionally traveled a full vehicle-width off the road surface - with both tires off the road - which scene, Scene A or Scene B, would more likely cause the vehicle to roll over while attempting to get back onto the highway?

Answer: Scene B
