

## Classroom Instruction

There are two classroom periods that are led by a classroom instructor. One is in the morning following the in-vehicle pre-tests, and the second one is in the afternoon approximately following lunch. See the day's schedule for more detail on times of classroom.

### 1. Morning Classroom

- a. A PowerPoint, "1. Montana Teen Class," is provided to facilitate the lecture. At the slide that talks about additional speed causing wheel to leave the road, a demonstration is provided by the teacher. Stop the PowerPoint at this point and conduct the demonstration.
- b. The speed demonstration will be more thoroughly documented in a later narrative. It basically uses a small "frisbe" type saucer and match box cars. The cars will roll around the inside perimeter, but as you increase the incline of the "frisbe" and thereby increase the speed of the model car, the car will fly off the "frisbe", simulating what happens in a corner with too much speed.
- c. Resume and complete the PowerPoint lecture.

### 2. Afternoon Classroom

- a. Conduct the afternoon PowerPoint lecture, "2. Montana Teen Class."
