You are invited to stop by the *US 191 Corridor Study* Open House. The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT), in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), local jurisdictions, resource agencies, and the public, is developing a corridor study of US Highway 191 (US 191) between Four Corners (RP 81.9) and Beaver Creek Road south of Big Sky (RP 45.3). The purpose of the *US 191 Corridor Study* is to develop a comprehensive long-range plan for managing the corridor. The study will identify feasible improvement options to address safety, operational, and geometric concerns within the study area.

The open house is an opportunity for stakeholders, adjacent land owners, and other members of the public to speak directly with study staff, ask questions, and learn about the corridor planning process.

To better serve local residents and roadway users, the open houses will be held in two locations. The format of each open house will be the same. You are welcome to attend whichever day and location is most convenient for you.
