

# Project Update



The plans for improvements to the Interstate 15 Gore Hill Interchange are moving forward in the design process. The Montana Department of Transportation anticipates presenting the final detailed design plans to the public in Fall 2022. A construction date has not been determined.

## Planned improvements include:

- Building a wider overpass bridge with a sidewalk.
- Adding two single-lane roundabouts with truck aprons at each on- and off-ramp intersection.
- Adding a sidewalk between the roundabout intersections.
- Adding an additional southbound lane on I 15 between the Gore Hill Interchange (Exit 277) and the 10th Avenue South Interchange (Exit 278).
- Relocating a portion of Tri Hill Frontage Road near the Town Pump to the south.
