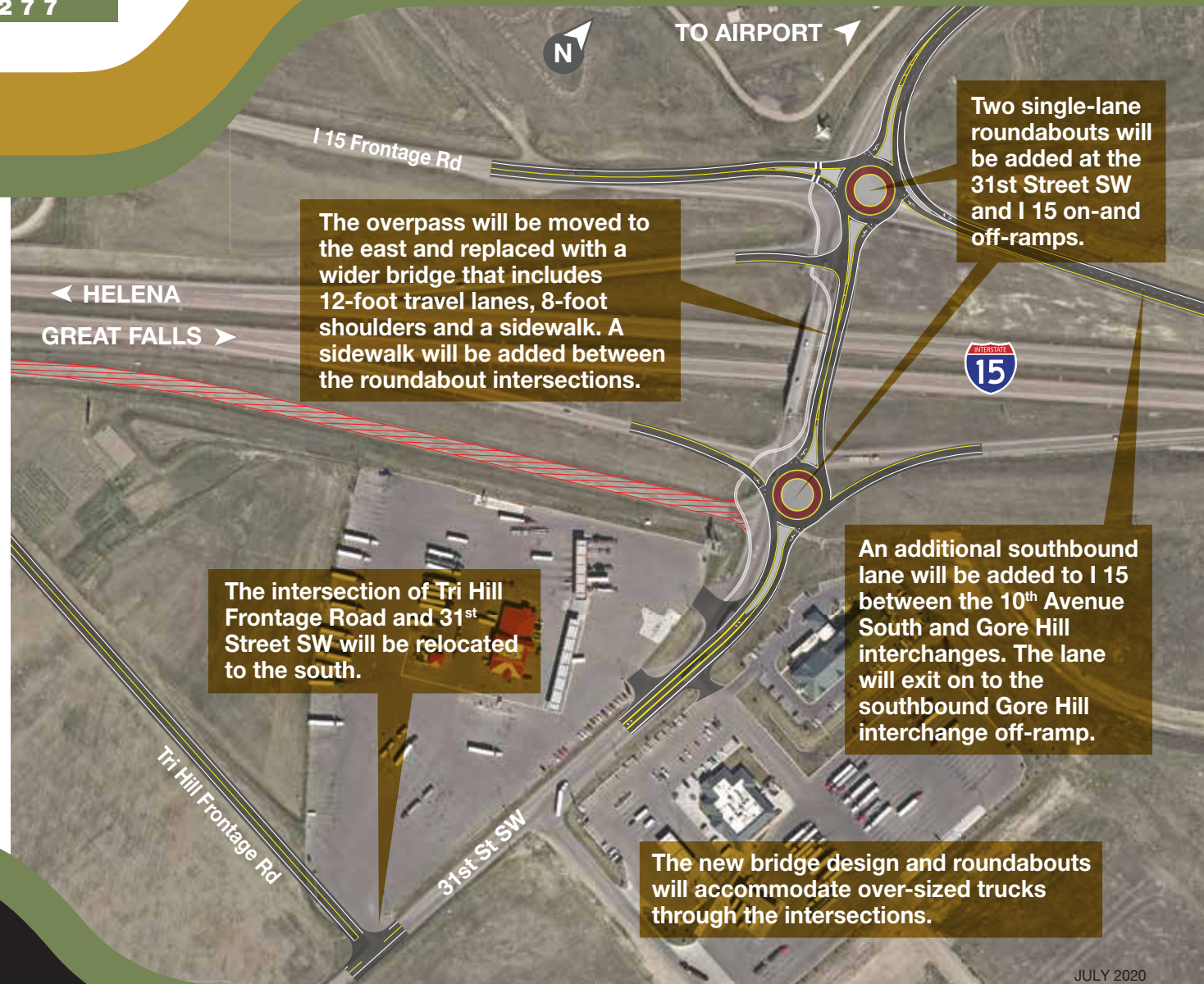


PROJECT UPDATE

The Montana Department of Transportation is developing improvements to the Interstate 15 Gore Hill Interchange (Exit 277) in Great Falls. The project will reduce delays, and improve traffic flow and safety on I 15 between 10th Avenue South and the Gore Hill Interchange. MDT has selected a new interchange design and is developing detailed plans to guide construction. A construction date has not been determined.

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You Spoke, We Listened

Based on community feedback received at the 2019 public meeting, MDT is also developing plans to replace the I 15 Gore Hill Interchange bridge. The new overpass structure will be built to the east of the current overpass to keep the interchange open during construction. The new bridge will be wider and include 12-foot travel lanes, 8-foot shoulders and a sidewalk.
