

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is conducting a corridor study on Montana Highway 3 (MT 3) in Billings, from Apache Trail to the roundabout that connects to East Airport Road and North 27th Street near Billings Logan International Airport. The study began in January 2025 and has a planned completion date in December 2025. MDT recognizes the importance of this study to the Billings community and has developed corridor recommendations based on needs, public and agency input, and financial feasibility. This open house will present suggested recommendations from the draft Improvements Options Report and the draft Access Management Plan.
