PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is conducting a corridor study on Montana Highway 3 (MT 3) in Billings, from Apache Trail to the roundabout that connects to East Airport Road and North 27th Street near Billings Logan International Airport. The purpose of the *Montana 3 Billings Corridor Study* is to develop a comprehensive long-range plan for managing the corridor and identify opportunities to improve the corridor, including the development of an Access Management Plan to enhance safety and efficiency. The study began in January 2025 and has a planned completion date in December 2025.
