



# Construction Ahead

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) and its construction partner, Riverside Contracting, will rehabilitate approximately 7 miles of Interstate 15 (I 15) near Wolf Creek.

The project area begins 5 miles south of Wolf Creek and extends north to the Augusta Interchange (Exit 228). This project is anticipated to begin in spring 2023 and will take three years to complete.

**Improvements include:**

- Removing and replacing the top 2 feet of degraded roadway material and resurfacing adjacent ramps, crossroads, and pullouts.
- Upgrading concrete barrier rails, metal guardrails, and signage.
- Adding road delineators (roadside markers) on inside curves.
- Replacing right-of-way fencing and cattle guards as needed.
- Updating curb ramps on Walsh Street between Main Street and Recreation Road.
- Upgrading storm drainage in the town of Wolf Creek.
- Lining and repairing I 15 culverts.
- Improving erosion control features.
- Adding new pavement markings.

# I 15 WOLF CREEK NORTH & SOUTH



## Why is this project needed?

**MDT identified this stretch of interstate as being worn down and in need of repairs.**

This project will address the deteriorated roadway in a manner that will provide a smooth driving surface and decrease maintenance costs for many years. The upgraded signage and roadway markers were included as part of this project to enhance safety along this corridor.

## What to expect during construction

For the safety of the public and workers, MDT encourages motorists to plan ahead, allow extra travel time, slow down, and use caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Both north and southbound traffic will travel on the same side of I 15.
- Crossover traffic patterns will be in place throughout construction.
- Speed limits will be reduced.
- A 12-foot width restriction will be in place.
- Access to Wolf Creek and Augusta Interchange on- and off-ramps will be maintained.
