

- This is Community's opportunity to take advantage of Recovery Dollars to build a portion of the Kalispell Bypass, sooner rather than later.



American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 Transportation Infrastructure





ARRA Purpose of Legislation

Recovery

- Maintain and create jobs
- Infuse cash into cash strapped state programs
- Encourage flow of money into the economy through tax cuts and other incentives for individuals and organizations

Reinvest

Build and repair infrastructure



ARRA Transportation Funding Overview

Section	Funding Type	\$ Amount Per Act	Estimated \$ for Montana
Highways	Formula Grants	\$27.5 billion	\$211 million
Highways	Discretionary	\$1.5 billion	Competitive
Transit	Urbanized Areas Billings: Great Falls: Missoula:	\$5.97 billion	\$4.3 million -\$1.8 million -\$1.2 million -\$1.2 million
Transit	Rural General Public	\$760 million	\$11.2 million



Project Timetables to Drive Recovery: Highways: \$211 million

Highway Infrastructure Timeframes:

- 50% within 120 days of federal apportionment (June 17, 2009)
- Remainder within 1-year of enactment (February 17, 2010)
- Redistributed funds through Sept. 30, 2010 (funds not meeting above timeframes)



Project Conditions to Drive Recovery: Highways - \$211 million

Eligible Projects:

- Surface Transportation Program eligibilities:
 - Examples: Highway and Bridge, Highways Safety
 Projects, Bicycle/Pedestrian Improvements

Eligible Recipients:

- State DOTs, MPOs greater than 200,000 population Priority Projects
- Expected completion within 3-years of ARRA enactment
- Located in economically distressed areas
- Project delivery (50% by 6/17/2009) and Remainder by 2/17/2010)
- Job creation/savings & other economic benefits

- Congressional Budget Office & Government Accountability Office Reports
- Reports by Council of Economic Advisors



Additional Federal Oversight – All Recovery Projects


- Inspector General Reviews
- Access to Records & Employees: by inspector general
- Federal Recovery Accountability & Transparency Board
- Federal Recovery Independent Advisory Panel: fraud, waste & abuse



Summary of MDT Project List

- 69 candidate projects @ \$234 Million
- Projects include resurfacing to reconstruction
- Considerations for urban, rural & tribal projects
 - Urban approximately \$75 million
 - Includes Transportation Enhancements over \$6 mil.
 - Rural over \$159 million
 - Includes Tribal approximately \$39 million
- Considerations for geographic distribution, economically distressed areas, jobs created or sustained, project delivery

US 2 South (interim 2-lane) Cost Estimates (in millions)

Construction: \$33.1

Const. Engineering: \$ 3.3

Utilities/Incidental Const: \$ 1.2

IDC not charged to ARRA \$ -2.3

Total Costs:

\$35.3

Remaining Earmarks and other funding

MDT Right-of-Way (ROW) Process

- Appraise Parcel
 - Completed by State Certified Appraiser
 - Appraise "as-is" value of Land & Improvements
 - Appraise "after" value
 - Can reflect loss of trees, building, etc.
 - Review Appraisal by State Qualified Reviewer
- Acquire Parcel
 - Make Offer, Based upon Appraised Value
 - Acquisition
 - ROW Agreement and Deeds
- Close Parcel (owned by MDT)




US 2 South – ROW Status

(number of parcels as of 3/29/09)

- 30 Appraisal Process
- 32 Acquisition Process
- 4 Agreement Pending
- 24 Closed
- 38 Owner Notification/Access Control Only
- 128 Total Parcels
