



1. What's and where is this project?

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is rehabilitating four bridges in the Livingston area. This includes the bridge that carries U.S. Highway 89 (US 89) over Interstate 90 (I-90) at Exit 340, the bridge that carries US 89 over I-90 at Exit 337, the bridge that carries US 89 over the Yellowstone River north of Exit 340, and Carter's Bridge on East River Road over the Yellowstone River. Repairs and improvements will vary from bridge to bridge on this project.

2. What improvements are being made?

- Concrete bridge overlays
- Bridge deck (driving surface) repairs
- Bridge deck crack sealing
- Modification or replacement of bridge barrier rail and guardrail
- Bridge beam and structural repair
- Permanent erosion control improvements

3. What is the project schedule?

Work on this project is anticipated to begin in April 2026 and be completed in a single season. Construction is planned to take place during daylight hours.

4. What should I expect during construction?

- Reduced speed limits
- Temporary signals or flaggers directing traffic at times
- Temporary lane closures
- A 10-foot width restriction on the bridges (Visit [511mt.net](https://www.511mt.net) for up-to-date information on width restrictions for individual structures)
- Detours at Exit 340 for US 89 traffic

5. Is there a detour in place?

Yes, MDT and the contractor decided that closing the US 89 bridge at Exit 340 would be required to complete work at that site. During this closure all traffic should detour to the next exit on the interstate. I-90 eastbound traffic should travel to Exit 343 to turn around, return to I-90 westbound, and then take Exit 340 to access US 89 north. Additionally, traffic traveling southbound on US 89 seeking to enter eastbound I-90 will need to first enter westbound I-90 and use Exit 337 to turn around and enter eastbound I-90.
