

US 93 NORTH - POST CREEK HILL

MDT is working alongside a team of Montana-based engineering experts to develop a highly complex project. Partners include Morrison-Maierle, Inc., SK Geotechnical, Kiewit Infrastructure Corp., Krebs Corp., KLJ Engineering, and DOWL.

Post Creek Hill reconstruct:

- Widening the roadway to include 8-foot-wide shoulders. Constructing a northbound truck climbing lane at Post Creek Hill.
- Constructing left-turn lanes at major intersections.
- Installing a new bridge over Post Creek that facilitates wildlife movement underneath the highway.
- Constructing a shared-use path.









US 93 - NINEPIPE EAGLE PASS TRAIL

MDT is working alongside a team of engineering and construction experts to advance these important improvements. Partners include Sundt-Schellinger (a Joint Venture), DOWL, DJ&A, and Jacobs.

Ninepipes Area reconstruct:

- Roadway reconstruction with widened shoulders.
- Three new highway bridges.
- One wildlife overpass.
- Shared use-path facilities.
- Wildlife fencing and accommodation features.
- Intersection improvements.
- Drainage updates.














MDT is committed to Vision Zero – the goal of zero deaths and zero serious injuries on Montana's roadways.

Our approach to improving safety on our roadways focuses on key elements of traffic safety – also known as the four "Es":


- EDUCATION through public information and traffic safety outreach campaigns.
