Any indication or knowledge of fraud, waste, abuse or mismanagement of the DBE funds should immediately be reported to the Montana Dept. of Transportation (MDT), Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), or to the Office of the Inspector General, U.S. Department of Transportation. Callers may be anonymous and may request that their identity be protected.

Issues that should be reported:

- Contract, Procurement, and Grant Fraud
- Environmental, Health, and Safety Violations
- Computer Crimes
- Product Substitution and Suspect/Counterfeit Parts
- Bribery, Kickbacks, and Gratuities
- False Statements and False Claims
- Conflicts of Interest and Ethics Violations
- Travel Fraud
- Theft and/or Abuse of Government property
- Stimulus Abuse: American Recovery and Investment Act of 2009 (ARRA) violations
- Other Violations of Federal Laws and Regulations
