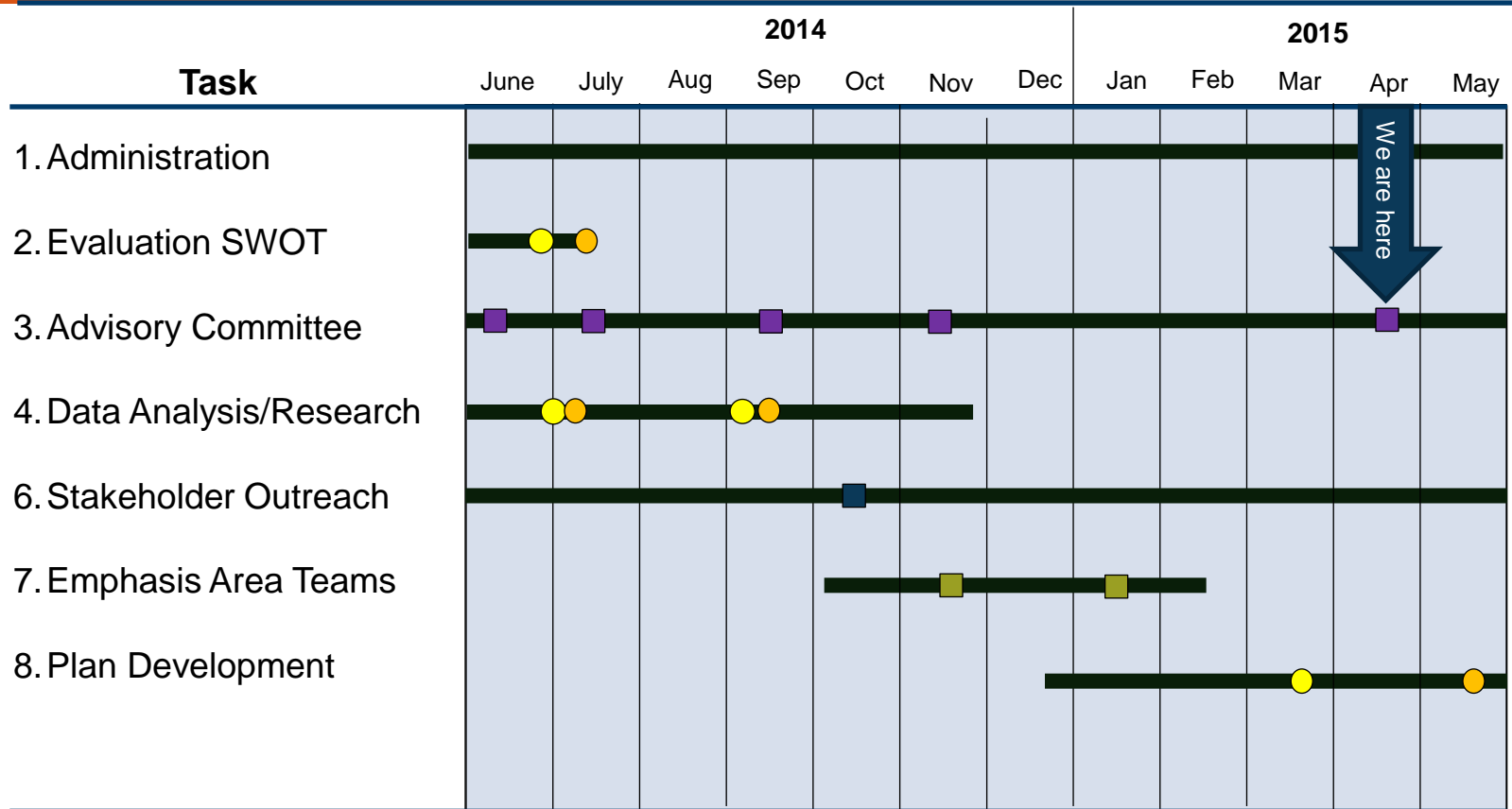

# Montana Comprehensive Highway Safety Plan

## Purpose

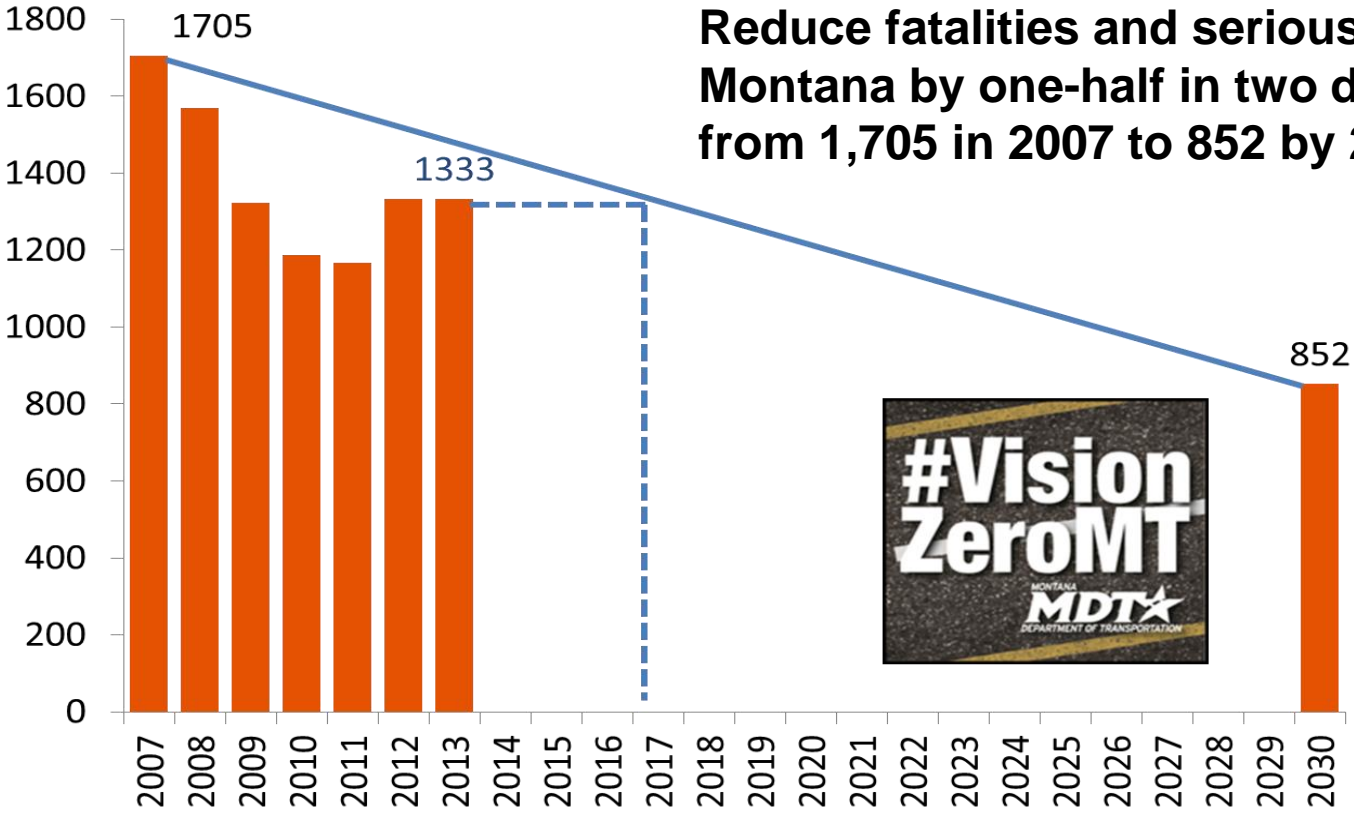
**Implement a collaborative process to reduce fatalities and serious injuries in Montana utilizing engineering, enforcement, education, and emergency response strategies. The CHSP will seek to focus resources strategically, where opportunities for safety improvements are greatest.**

# Vision Zero

- » The vision for safety on Montana's roadways is clear: Vision Zero: zero fatalities and zero serious injuries

Serious Injury Rate	9.2	5.9	-.37	-5.1%

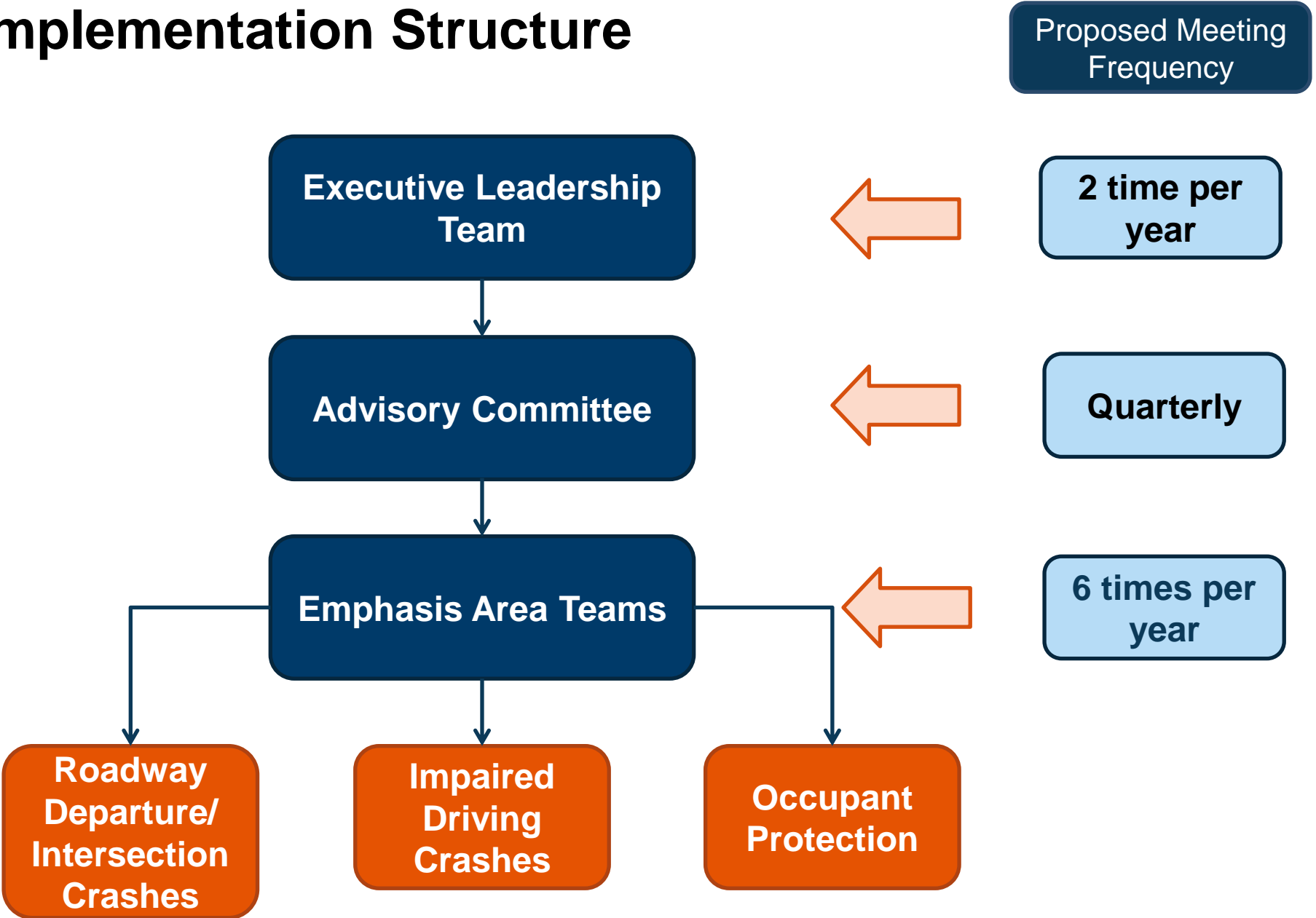

# Executive Leadership Team – Role and Responsibilities

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- » **Prioritize and institutionalize safety, Vision Zero, across agencies**
- » **Commit revenue, personnel and technical resources to implement statewide safety initiatives**
- » **Identify & remove barriers within and between agencies to achieve Vision Zero**

# Executive Leadership Team – Role and Responsibilities

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- » **Incorporate common safety strategies and initiatives into agency plans and policies**
- » **Provide leadership and collaboration addressing statewide safety needs**

# Advisory Committee – Role and Responsibilities

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- » **Discuss implementation progress and coordinate next steps**
- » **Provide assistance to overcome barriers or solve problems, and report to Executive Committee**
- » **Provide guidance and direction to Emphasis Area Teams on federal**
- » **Provide oversight to ensure that Emphasis Areas evaluate the effectiveness of strategies and actions to ensure they are contributing to decreases in fatalities and severe injuries**

# Advisory Committee – Role and Responsibilities

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- » **Coordinate & communicate - related safety campaigns, trainings, or other programs**
- » **Recommend topics for which decisions are needed by the Executive Leadership Team**
- » **Ensure continuous consideration is given to the overarching strategies**

- **Emergency Medical Services**
- **Safety Culture**

# Emphasis Area Team Leaders – Role and Responsibilities

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**With support from the CHSP Coordinator**

- » **Ensure team membership is multidisciplinary and includes representatives from the 4Es of safety**
- » **Schedule and facilitate meetings of the group**
- » **Prepare meeting agendas, reports/minutes including action items after each meeting**

# Emphasis Area Team Leaders – Role and Responsibilities

- » **Track progress on implementation of the Emphasis Area Strategies with assistance from the various action step leaders**
  - **Notify the Advisory Committee if assistance is needed on implementation of any action step.**
  
- » **Seek input and assistance from specialists on approaches to implementing existing actions or developing new actions**
  
- » **Seek assistance from Advisory Committee to help implement a task or project or overcome a barrier**

# Emphasis Area Team Leaders – Role and Responsibilities

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- » Provide quarterly progress reports to Advisory Committee and share Advisory Committee feedback and direction with the team
- » Periodically review Emphasis Area actions – update or identify new actions where appropriate
- » Update team members on relevant research/news, i.e., national, state, or local news, new research results, tools, and events
