Mini Grant Opportunities:

- Intended for shorter term projects
- Must align with CHSP
- Eligibility (non-profit, tribal, governmental entities)
- Impaired Driving: Non-Enforcement
- Occupant Protection
- Law Enforcement

Impaired Driving: Non-enforcement Mini-grant Program

- Assistance for state/local projects intended to reduce impaired driving (alcohol and/or drug). Non-enforcement.
- Short term projects that encourages state/local collaboration
- Max of \$5,000
- Funding Opportunity is open ended
- Apply through Montana Web grants

Youth Connections of Helena

- Local Drugged Driving Prevention Campaign
- Youth Connections of Helena collaborated with Carroll College Students: Public Health Theories & Practice class. College Credit

State Highway Traffic Safety Mini-Grant Program Law Enforcement

- All of our programs, including the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) have specific requirements for using federal funds.
- Only a handful of Montana's Law Enforcement agencies can consistently satisfy all of the requirements set forth in the STEP scope of work.
- Montana Sheriff's and Peace Officer's Association administered STEP funds to multiple smaller agencies
- In FFY 2014 we re-evaluated how to get overtime funding to smaller agencies in a more targeted fashion.
- FFY 2015 was the first use of NHTSA funds for the Mini-Grant Program

State Highway Traffic Safety Mini-Grant Program Law Enforcement

- Montana Law Enforcement Liaison Program.
- Provide outreach and education regarding HVE and Mini-Grants
- Assist with the grant application process and the requirements for the grant.

Law Enforcement Mini-grant Program

- 2015 – 2018, MDT has funded 51 Mini-Grant requests for Law Enforcement.
- Requests range from the Winter Carnival in Red Lodge to Topless Tuesday in Alzada.
- Many requests are focused on the Summer Driving Season
